



Did You Know . . . ?

Old Testament

- Abraham lived just over 1,000 years after cuneiform, the earliest form of writing, was invented.
- Abraham was from the ancient city of Ur in southern Mesopotamia, near modern-day Basra, Iraq.
- When Moses fled Egypt, he went to the land of Midian, today in Saudi Arabia.
- The “Red Sea” that God parted for Moses and the Israelites may have been the Gulf of Suez or another large body of water near where the Suez Canal is today.
- Ruth was from the land of Moab, today in Jordan, east of the Dead Sea.
- The ark of the covenant was likely destroyed by Babylon with the temple, but in Revelation 11:19 John writes about seeing it in his vision of God’s temple.
- The rule of the Mayans in Central America began during the same time in history as King David’s reign in Israel.
- Water still flows through Hezekiah’s Tunnel, thought to have been dug during the eighth century BC or earlier.
- God sent Jonah to preach in Nineveh, which lies on the outskirts of the modern-day city of Mosul, Iraq.

New Testament

- Jesus went to locations in four modern-day countries: Israel, Egypt, Jordan, and Lebanon.
- At the time Jesus was born, the Roman Empire extended as far as France, Spain, Tunisia, Egypt, and Turkey.
- Most of Jesus’ twelve disciples were from towns surrounding the Sea of Galilee.
- John the Baptist was imprisoned and executed in (most likely) Machaerus, Herod’s fortress/palace near the Dead Sea.
- The 365-day calendar we use today was introduced just a few years before Paul’s first missionary journey.
- Paul traveled as a missionary through Syria, Turkey, Greece, and Italy.
- The Temple of Artemis in Ephesus, where crowds rioted as Paul preached, was one of the seven wonders of the world.
- The seven churches in Revelation were located along major travel routes in Asia Minor, in Turkey today.
- By the end of the first century, there were Christian churches as far as Carthage (Tunisia), Edessa (Turkey), and Alexandria (Egypt).
