## How Long Was Jesus' Ministry?


One way to measure the length of Jesus' public ministry is by counting the number of Passovers in John's gospel. John mentions four Passovers (John 2:13; 5:1; 6:4; 13:1); the first one very early in Jesus' ministry and the last one in Jesus' final week in Jerusalem. (The festival in John 5:1 is believed to be either Passover itself or another festival near the Passover season.) This means that Jesus' ministry continued for at least three years.

## Are the Gospel Stories in Chronological Order?

Modern biographies typically narrate the events of a person's life in the order in which they occurred, but biographies in the time of Jesus were quite different. Though ancient biographers put big events into historical sequence, they didn't place every activity in chronological order. Instead, it was more important to develop an accurate picture of the person's character. While the gospels provide us with very similar stories about Jesus, the order of some events across the four gospels doesn't always match up. That's because the main purpose of each gospel was to show the reader who Jesus was and what his life means for us.

Though Bible scholars today differ about the precise sequence of events in the life of Jesus, we have tried to ensure that the material presented here is consistent with widely held interpretations of the basic chronology in the gospels.








